

Turtle Pack is a swim aid which is to be worn on the back. It consists of a neoprene vest and foam turtle shell. The product is a teaching device to help children learn to swim.

It is strongly advised that when young children wear the product for the first time that they are supported in the water until they learn and understand how buoyancy works. This advice should be given for all swimming aids as children need time to adjust and adapt to new equipment. The product will not protect against drowning and should only be worn under constant and competent supervision. The product should not be bitten or chewed by the user as pieces that may be bitten off/torn from/come away from the material may cause a choking hazard.

Turtle Pack is designed in accordance to the EN13138 1:2014; for the age range of 2-6-year-olds or equivalent weight of 15-30 KG and complies with PPE Regulation (EU) 2016/425.

As the child's confidence improves in the water the buoyancy can be reduced by removing segments of the shell. The shells provide an approximate buoyancy: i)Full product is 40N; ii) Without outer shell is 28N; Without outer shell & middle shell is 21N. Therefore the outer shell and middle shell are 12N & 7N respectively. The shells have a lifespan of 10 years.
